

Padded Phone Cover

These instructions are based on my phone which measures 3" wide x 6" long – you will need to adjust the sizes if your phone is bigger

You will need:

2 main and 2 lining pieces of fabric 5½" x 7¼"

2 pieces of wadding 5½" x 7"



Instructions:

- Start with quilting. On the main fabric pieces, draw a line diagonally on the right side from the top left corner to the bottom right corner. Draw additional lines 1" apart. Then repeat from the top right corner to the bottom left corner
- Place the pieces of main fabric face up on top of the wadding and, starting at the top corner, stitch down the line using a longer stitch
- Continue until you have stitched along all of the lines to give a diamond pattern



- With right sides together, pin the front to the back and round the bottom corners. Stitch them together using a ½" seam and leaving the top open
- Stitch the lining the same way
- Trim off excess fabric, especially around the corners to reduce the bulk
- Turn the lining to the right side and push inside the main case

- Line up the seams and stitch together $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the top edge, leaving a gap for turning
- Pull through to the right side and fold the open edges inwards – press the edges then pin the gap closed and top stitch close to the edge

Finished size $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "



Alternatives

- Instead of having 2 pieces of everything, just use one but twice as wide
- Add a tab with a button and buttonhole or poppers at the top if you would rather have a closure
